

Home Service Information

Eligibility

This service is available to those who live within four miles of the City of Wautoma who are temporarily or permanently unable to visit the library due to an illness, disability, or other qualifying circumstances.

Is there a cost?

No! This service is absolutely free to patrons. The only charges that may be assessed would be for lost or damaged materials.

How to sign up

Complete the inside of this application with your contact information and what kinds of library materials you would like to receive. Return the brochure to the library (via in person, email, or mail) and the library staff will contact you.

How it works

Based on your preferences, we will select materials and check them out to your library card. (Don't have a card? We can get you one!) A library volunteer will make a scheduled visit to deliver your new materials and return your finished items to the library.

Safety

All library staff and volunteers have passed background checks. For the safety of all parties, volunteers are not allowed to enter your home. You will exchange your library materials at the door.
